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somebody who was acting on behalf of Senator Stuhr, and it only had about four lines to it. This amendment has considerably more material. It goes to more pages in the bill and, not having had the opportunity to review them, I would to divide the question. And if you'd like Senator Jensen and I to approach, then we can do that, if that's what you would like us to do.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I would, Senator Chambers. Please come forward. Thank you. Senator Jensen, you also. Thank you. There's been a request, division of the question before us. I have ruled that it is divisible. The request is by Senator Chambers. Mr. Clerk, please read how the question was divided.

CLERK: Mr. President, there will be six components to the amendment, as offered by Senators Jensen and Stuhr. The first amendment, Senator Jensen, may I assume we'll just take them up in the order on the sheet, Senator? Is that okay with you? Okay.

SENATOR JENSEN: On amendment.

CLERK: Very good. Thank you. Mr. President, in that case, the amendment offered by Senator Jensen would be lines 1 and 2 of AM2748, lines 1 and 2 of AM2748. (FA1472, Legislative Journal page 711.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. As stated, the question was divided. We'll take them up in order, Senator Jensen has stated, as they come. Lines 1 and 2, Senator Jensen, to open on the first part of the divided question.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. On lines 1 and 2, actually on page 15, we're striking the word "board" and inserting the word "department," because there really isn't a board and so it better reflects the actual terminology of department. The word "board" really doesn't belong in there. This would clarify that and make it the department. With that, I'd return the rest of the time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Was there
