ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 718.) 30 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the confirmation report, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. It has been adopted. Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next confirmation report offered by the Health and Human Services Committee is two appointments to the Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board. (Legislative Journal page 671.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on your report.

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. To the Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board we have two appointments. Jennie Cole-Mossman, new appointment, a child and adolescent mental health practitioner here in Lincoln, and she is also a foster parent. Number two is Debra Phelps, also a new appointment. She's from Papillion, mother of a child with Shaken Baby Syndrome, established a support group for parents of children with Shaken Baby Syndrome, and has worked in that area for some time. I would move the adoption of this report, Mr. President.
