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SENATOR FOLEY: Yield my time to Senator Smith, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I do want to, I guess, reiterate the fact that I believe is reality regarding the petition initiatives. Now, Senator Stuthman, maybe fairly, characterized my (laugh), although I would say it's not accurate, my position that maybe I'm okay with the slot machines in every bar across Nebraska. Senator Stuthman, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuthman, would you yield?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes.

SENATOR SMITH: Senator Stuthman, now, was I accurate in portraying your assessment of my position just now?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, I made the comment, you know, in the conversation that I heard prior on your statements that, you know, you were totally against casino gambling.

SENATOR SMITH: Right. Now, certainly I will say that I don't believe we want slot machines in bars across Nebraska. Would you agree with that, with your own position?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, I would.

SENATOR SMITH: So you don't want bars turning into casinos, or slot machines, video slot machines or otherwise, in bars across Nebraska?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: My position is that I'm not in favor of having it accessible, you know, as a very, you know, numerous establishments throughout the state, as far as video slots, video poker, you know, at the liquor establishments.

SENATOR SMITH: Okay. Thank you. Thank you, Senator Stuthman. Mr. President, colleagues, I want to, again, look at the issue
