SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SMITH: ...sticky sense that so often Senator Beutler raises. So I urge the vote to overrule the Chair, and hope that we can do that and move on. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. You've heard the closing on the motion by Senator Smith to overrule the Chair on the Chair's ruling on the germaneness issue of FA1478 to AM2670 to LR 14CA. This does require a majority of the members present, which is currently 22 members. The question before the body is, shall the Chair be overruled? All in favor vote yes, all opposed no. The question before the body is, shall the Chair be overruled? It does require 22 votes to be successful, a majority of those present. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to overrule the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was not successful. The Chair was not overruled. Senator Schimek, for what purpose did you rise?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. President, I would like to withdraw my amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is withdrawn.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Smith, FA1481, Senator, as an amendment to your amendment. (Legislative Journal page 748.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, you're recognized to open on your amendment to your amendment.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President and members. It's a rather simple amendment. It...instead of the five-year renewal,
