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SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR COMBS: ...in that we're strong and that we give strength to what we uphold. The other way we can be a pillar is when we stand in the way and refuse to move and dig in our heels, regardless of the common sense behind the issue. So we can become a pillar one of two ways, and I would imagine again that's a perception issue for each of us. But let's stop and take a look at what we're doing, why we're doing it, and where we're going before we waste any more time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Combs. Senator Stuthman.
