I received the notice from the...of the adjudicator's determination from the Department of Labor, saying that 'his nurse was only qualified for 8...disqualified for 8 weeks, c en though the description on the document talked about the negligence and carelessness. Now, this is a pretty serious offense, in my view, pretty serious, and she only got 8 weeks. And for your constituent to get 10, there's got to be more to the story. And I know that Senator Chambers says that this is a terrible bill. But we are only, only going after the people that have quit without good cause, or fired for misconduct. Those are the only people. They can control their own destiny...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: ...by just trying to be a little bit better employee, in most of those cases. And I'm going to go more into the bill and give you more examples of case law when we get talking more about the bill. I'd like to get to a vote on the amendments now. But I want to stress again, I am not out there to hurt people that lose their job through no fault of their own. I absolutely am not out to do that. Only for people that do some of the things Senator Combs talked about, Senator Brown the other day--I hope she will talk about her situation again--Senator Kruse, Senator Smith. Those are the types of things I am trying to get after. You know, it's a very common misconception out there. I had one person call me, and they stated, well, I pay into this, I pay into this, I should be able to collect. Well, that is an absolute falsehood. The employee pays nothing into the...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: ...unemployment system, not one red cent.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.
