The whole point in this bill, it's to make people think twice before they quit for no good reason. I can see absolutely no reason they should collect at all. That's how cold I am. If they quit for no good reason, they shouldn't collect. And in 45 other states, they don't. But here in Nebraska, we let them collect. And even if my bill passes...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: ...they still would be eligible for 13 weeks of unemployment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Cunningham.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Combs was laying out for us the alternatives or options that a person has who is disqualified from receiving benefits and the disqualification may not have been justified. Anybody with familiarity with the court system knows the amount of time it takes to get a case docketed and heard. If somebody is without funds, to send that person to a drawn-out court proceeding is the height of cruelty. To say that that person can get into district court without having to pay fees is a statement without meaning. If a person has a right that the court is going to vindicate and that person is indigent, that person does not have to pay the fees. So what she told us is how cruel the system really is and how heartless are those who support a bill like this. They have the Marie Antoinette philosophy. The people have no bread? She said, let them eat cake. And I will let you read history to see what the outcome of her sassy remark was for her. Members of the Legislature, Senator Combs, and I'm not going to include Senator Cunningham because it would do no good, justice delayed is justice denied. If a person is improperly discharged and has to go through an involved proceeding to have that injustice rectified, while going through the proceeding that person is without funds.
