We are on Final Reading, and as the Speaker has put on, pursuant to any bill listed on Final Reading which has an amendment filed to it will be removed from today's agenda by the Speaker's orders. There is an amendment...Mr. Clerk, read the amendment. As the Clerk stated, there is an amendment filed to LB 236 so that will be...there is no amendment to LB 236. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 236 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 236 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 759.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 236 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 382, the title please...the bill.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 382 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 382 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 759-760.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 2 excused and voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 382 passes. As per our agenda, there has been a motion filed against LB 454, so we will be passing over that bill. Mr. Clerk, LB 740.
