SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to have committed the offense. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. You've heard the opening. Members, it is a little noisy in here and it's hard...difficult to hear the speaker, so would you please show some consideration and hold the conversation down. Thank you very much. On with discussion on the motion to return to Select File for specific amendment, Senator Jones, followed by Senators Vrtiska and Chambers.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. Speaker, and members of the body, I've went over this amendment that I see that Senator Chambers has filed to this bill and I have to agree with him on there. An officer can stop somebody, that they can arrest them, but they cannot prosecute them. And I think that that should be taken out and I'll have to agree with him on that. I understand that the words "and prosecute" comes out in line 11, and in 12 line, it comes out, "and see that they are properly prosecuted according to law" comes out in lines 12 and 13. And then 16, the word "deemed" comes out. So I don't have no problem with them three things coming out, and I think that that should be done before we can more it on. So I'll support his amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Vrtiska, on the motion to return.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, members of the body. I am not going to speak very long or about very much except I feel I've been insulted and defamed and almost assaulted by Senator Chambers this morning, so I have to respond. I think it's only fair that I get a moment to do that. First of all, Senator Chambers wasn't at the hearing yesterday, which is his fault not mine, and it would have been a grand time to have him there to discuss this very issue that he is talking about this morning rather than here on the floor.
