may not be sure what your name is because I think I heard somebody say he thinks I'm referring to you. Have we talked about this amendment?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: We, just in the last few minutes we have discussed the amendment, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And is it okay with you?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, it's okay with me because in looking at the amendment, when a person...if a person was making a statement of conversation, an individual would probably say "candidate for any city or village office." I think that would be easier and more fluent as you would speak in the normal tone of language, you know, any county...or city, village office. Here I can see where it does state, you know, "candidate for city or village office." It is correct but it is not as fluent as it would be with the word "any" in it and I would agree with the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's all I would have, Mr. President. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the opening on the motion to return. Discussion? There are no lights on, Senator Chambers. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is, shall LB 323 be returned to Select File for a specific amendment? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
