PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The report is adopted. Next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next report from the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee is on the appointment of Donna Wanitschke to the State Highway Commission. (Legislative Journal page 736.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Chair would recognize Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members. This is a reappointment to the State Highway Commission, Donna Wanitschke from Grand Island. She's been on the State Highway Commission since 1989; a reappointment, as I said.
