Telecommunications Committee would report on the appointments to the Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. That report is in the Journal on page 736.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Chair would recognize Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members. This is appointments to the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. They are responsible for the issuance and regulation of licenses, in accordance with statute, for motor vehicle dealers. We have a group of four to...that were appointed: the first, Jack Henry from Aurora, he is president of a manufactured housing company there in Aurora; Toby Miller from Valentine is an auto dealer in Cherry County; Darlene Noah, she is from Kimball, she also is a president of a manufactured housing company based in Kimball; and Kelly Smith from North Platte, who is a car dealer there in Lincoln County, the North Platte area. They all come highly recommended. They're reappointments. I should qualify that. All but one, I believe, are reappointments. Did either appear in person or were represented in front of the committee, and I would encourage the body to confirm their appointments. Thank you.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Baker. Further discussion on the appointments? Seeing none, the Chair would recognize Senator Baker to close. He waives closing. The question is on the adoption of the confirmation report from the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee regarding the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board. All those in favor please vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
