SENATOR FRIEND: Awesome. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Okay.

SENATOR FRIEND: That's all. (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Friend. Any further discussion on the motion to advance LR 211CA? Seeing no lights on, Senator Chambers, did you wish to close on the advancement? You may if you wish to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Only to say that should there be an irresistible groundswell from all over the country that I be President of the United States, I might waffle just a little bit. That's my only close, Mr. President. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on advancement of LR 211CA. The question before the body is, should that LR 211CA advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on advancement of LR 211CA. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LR 211CA.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. It does advance. Mr. Clerk, next legislative bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: LB 947, Mr. President, by the Business and Labor Committee. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9, referred to the Business and Labor Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Vrtiska, as Chairman of the committee, you're recognized to open on LB 947.
