bill was read for the first time January 13, referred to the Government Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee amendments. (AM2516, Legislative Journal page 582.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Hartnett, to open on LB 1033.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Cudaback, members of the body, what it does, with the Athletic Board...this was brought by the athletic commissioner. It increased the board from three members to five members, and one of the members is a medical doctor physician with ringside experience, and the other would be a member at-large. Presently, the...right now, the member...one member has to have been active in amateur boxing, the other member had to be active in professional wrestling, and the other one had to be active in professional boxing. So it just simply increases the membership to five members. And I think there is a committee amendment. And I would...it sounds...emergency clause. So, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Schimek, as Chairperson of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, you're recognized to open on those committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. The committee amendment is simply the emergency clause, as Senator Hartnett mentioned. And I would urge support of the committee amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any discussion on the committee amendment to LB 1033? There are no lights on, Senator Schimek. Did you wish to close, or did you not? She waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of AM2516, offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay.
