just the edge of things and hoping that they'll go away, we never get nitty-gritty and get in there and find out what really happened. Because the only way you can do that sometimes is with committees and subpoenas. I'm not suggesting, Senator, that this is necessarily that kind of situation where you would want to dip into the authority or to use the authority of an investigating committee. I don't want to make it a bigger deal than it is. But I wanted to use this occasion to suggest what I feel is an omission of this Legislature, and maybe, given the time that they give us and the pay that they give us, there's nothing we can do about it, because God knows we're hard-pressed to do what they ask us to do just on the floor of this Legislature. But the people of the state ought to recognize that they're not getting a full value out of this Legislature the way they structure it, because they almost never get an investigating committee. And I suggest to you that there are many situations where you do not get to the truth of the matter unless people are under oath and brought before a committee, and I suggest to you that this, and it's maybe too small, but you aren't going to get to the truth of why she applied...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...to be on the environmental quality board unless you know what conversations were internally in that company. And you aren't going to get that information unless you have an investigating committee and the power of subpoena, and that's not going to happen on this case. But I wanted to say all that because it's been a frustration of mine for a long, long time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Beutler, your comments are well-taken. I'm one of those persons that chooses to believe the best in people. And I don't know what information she was free to share with us at the time of her confirmation hearing. This just came out in the paper yesterday. I don't know what her involvement was. And we don't know...even know what the violations are. I have no idea what the violations are, and I don't think that can
