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be shared with us. But I think if we...if we have 30 days, we can find out a lot more and then we can proceed. So that's what the...yeah, you're right, we should maybe question her integrity, but I don't think we should say anything too negative until we find out more. She's served since July and, near as we can tell, she's served very well since July. But that's part of the problem, is people get nominated and they serve and then ten months later we're here trying to decide whether they're a good member or not. And I would like to investigate with you and other people about how we can do to change the approval process, the nominating...the confirmation process. Sometimes we get the appointments too late, but there ought to be some kind of a system that somebody should be able to be nominated three, four, six months before they are...start serving and give the Legislature a chance to deal with it. As you know, you...as we all know, most of these confirmations are just simply a rubber stamp and we don't have people checking into them. There again, I will say, in her defense, my guess is this...any information about this will come to light and she'll be a good member and we will reconfirm her, but I don't know that, and so time should help us with that issue. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Friend.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, I was obviously involved, or at least there for the hearing in Natural Resources on Ms. Debra McDowell. I guess I rise in support of...I do rise in support of the reconsider motion, but I think we need to be clear about something here. Senator Schrock and everybody that's stood has spoke to this. This reconsideration solves nothing. It won't solve anything. It needs to be done, but this problem is a procedural problem. Two or three days ago I sat here with a cup of coffee and punched the button, the green, the green light, 37 times. I have no idea what I did. And I've just admitted it on the record, I have no idea what we've done. For the last two years, I've pushed the button, like a good soldier; I have no idea what I've done as far as these confirmations. The process is broken. What are we supposed to do here? We reconsider this one; I would submit to you that we could probably go out and find something that the World-Herald hasn't grabbed and reconsider
