even if it's going to be given. If somebody objected and said, well, I heard you gave that decision 10 days ago, and reached it and drafted an order, the person could say, well, it was my intention to get it to you and I'm working on that now, and there is nothing in here that would make the delivery of that information done...be done in an expeditious way. So I'm not asking for a definitive answer from you, but does it seem that maybe it would be a good idea to say something about the time frame within which these people should be given notice that a decision has been reached and an order drafted?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That seems like a good idea, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and if I get there and decide that there should be an amendment, then I would be prepared to discuss it. But since I hadn't gotten that far in my amending process, I don't want to offer an amendment because I want to say a word or two about what Senator Beutler was discussing in terms of the word "may" in dealing with certain other hearings. I had marked those places too. I thought what Senator Beutler was saying sounded very familiar to me, although I hadn't discussed it. If those hearings are to address an important matter, it should not be optional as to whether there will be a hearing. There should be a requirement so that anybody who'd be affected by the set of circumstances that would be the subject matter of a hearing would know that if a decision is going to be taken on those issues, there will be the opportunity to say something about whatever would be the subject of the hearing. So if the one who can make the decision says, yes, I'll have a hearing on it this time, then the next time, if a similar...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...thing comes up, the person says, I'm not going to have a hearing, it leaves too much to the discretion and, in some cases, the whim of such an individual. So when we get to that page, and I know you said you're going to look into it also, I may have something to offer. I'm showing discipline here this afternoon.
