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LB 962

SENATOR SCHROCK: There are no basin board...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...to the extent...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...that it doesn't say in the bill, your intent is that everybody has to agree in order to move forward under that particular language.

SENATOR SCHROCK: But I think they will have to be in agreement with each NRD. It can't be one agreement with four NRDs.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: We don't have any basin boards certainly recognized under law.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But each NRD has to agree with another NRD with regard to their ground water uses, do they not?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Not necessarily. Well, my counsel says in the Integrated Water Management Plan they have to agree, but one could agree and one could disagree. Then the one that disagrees I would assume would have to go mitigation...mediation, mediation,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...and the one could implement, if they needed to.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I was interested on the...on page 107, the Interrelated Water Review Board.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you
