SENATOR SCHROCK: Three of them have to be appointed from a list of six provided by members of the Natural Resources Commission. And that 16-member board, by the way, I did serve on that, that 16-member board has pretty good knowledge of the issues and certainly it represents a pretty broad statewide view.

SENATOR BEUTLER: You're just assuming that they would, without saying that they would appoint somebody...

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would assume they...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...knowledgeable.

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...would submit six well-qualified people who could serve on that board to the Governor.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I turned my light on in case Senator Beutler wanted more time, but I could offer my time to him or Senator Chambers if one of them wanted it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, did you wish any more time? He waives the opportunity. Senator Hartnett. Did you waive off also, Senator Hartnett? Senator Chambers, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close on FA1516 to FA1502.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, so far I've offered amendments that have generated no opposition, so it shows how reasonable I am being. And every amendment that I've offered so far has been adopted, so it shows that my colleagues are being reasonable. But in the process of going over these types of amendments, we are having some serious discussions on other areas of the bill. The one that Senator Beutler has been discussing with Senator Schrock is an area that caused me quite a bit of concern and I gave a lot of time to it. And it's the one that I had mentioned to Senator Schrock with reference to this board that the Governor appoints, the
