why. I don't want to serve on the Game and Parks Commission. But I can tell you, that seems to be apple. That's...as far as recruiting, I think if you want good people to serve on these boards and commissions, you have to recruit them, just like we recruit football players. So that's my offer to you. I shouldn't have brought up that last subject, but that's okay. That's my offer to you, or anybody else on the floor. I am not going to make statements about her qualifications or anything this morning, because I think it's...it would be improper to judge her now. Let's have another hearing, let's get some information in front of us. I would invite you to be a part of that. And with that, I would ask for your vote to return her name to the Natural Resources Committee, where we will hold another hearing on whether she should be confirmed or not.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You've heard the opening, confirmation report, offered by the Natural Resources Committee. Open for discussion on that motion. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature and Senator Schrock, I will not attend the hearing. I will not put myself in a position to question this nominee. I want the system of which the Legislature is a part to function properly. The proper way for our part of the system to function--by "our," I mean the Legislature--is to let the person appear before the appropriate committee, allow the members of that committee to do their job. And if they do not do their job appropriately, they will be excoriated on the floor of the Legislature. It is not my job, nor will I make it my job, to attend any other committee hearings. And I appreciate Senator Schrock's offer. I think it was made in good faith. And because this is a unique situation, sometimes it could call for a unique approach. But because I do not want to dismantle the system, but rather want to see it operate as it should, I will not do anything that steps outside of the way the system works. My shot at the whole thing is if and when a name comes before us on the floor of the Legislature. At that point, the committee, which has enough confidence in that person's qualifications to submit his or her name to us, will justify it. The committee members collectively, or the Chair, will answer all of our
