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the Governor presents to us, because it is impractical to say that we as individual Senators can do that work. Why does anybody think we have committees assigned to carry out those responsibilities? I think that that commission, or whatever name it goes by, is skewed toward those who are to be regulated. I now know that there are 16 members. But there are a lot of questions Senator Smith could ask me that I don't know the answer to. But by jing--Abraham Lincoln used to say that--I will find the answers. And if I think legislation is necessary, I will offer that legislation. But there is too much of a tendency for this Legislature to roll over and play dead if any entity has business connected to it. That's when the defenders pop up, one right after the other, like little bumps when you get the measles, or if you're outside and it's cold. Whenever a matter comes before the Legislature--and by that I mean it reaches the floor--and I am on this floor, I'm going to take all the time I need,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...all the time that I want to express my views, and I will do it in my own way. I won't try to please Senator Friend, who does things his own way. I won't try to please Senator...well, he's talking. I was going to say the "Silver Fox." And Senator Mines looked at me. I won't try to please Senator Mines. All of these senators have their own way of presenting their case. If one is as dull as a stick in the mud and he can't think of three words to say, he's not going to be able to say, well, since I don't say much, Senator Chambers ain't going to say much either. He's crazy if that would be his opinion and he thinks he's going to impose it on me. Or somebody else says, I don't like the examples Senator Chambers uses because I just go in a linear fashion from point A to point B and I don't use any examples, so Senator Chambers ought to be as limited as I am.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Nuts. What did you say, Mr. President?

SENATOR CUDABACK: I said time is up, Senator.
