SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA1517 to the first division of the divided committee amendments to LB 962. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is FA1517, offered by Senator Chambers to the first division of the divided committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on FA1517. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Senator Chambers, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will ask for a call of the house, and I'll accept call-in votes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. The question is, shall the house go under call? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 19 ayes, 1 nay to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Jensen. Senator Bromm, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Byars, Senator Combs. Senator Engel, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Foley, Senator Maxwell, Senator Thompson, Senator Bourne, Senator Baker. The house is under call. Senator Jensen, would you...Jensen, make that clear, would you check in, please? Senator Byars. Senators Bourne, Byars, and Jensen, check in, please. As been authorized, Senator Chambers has authorized call-in votes. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Connealy voting yes. Senator Combs voting yes. Senator Hudkins voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment, Mr. President.
