SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...regulatory aspect of the water law?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Of course, the natural resource district has members, and they could be called directors. The...there's a board of directors,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So...

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...but I think that would be spelled out differently, so there would be no misunderstanding.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Should we then, every time we're talking about the director of the National...of the Natural Resources...what did you say it's called?

SENATOR SCHROCK: The Natural Resources Commission.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Commission. We should say...

SENATOR SCHROCK: No. Natural Resources Department.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Should we say, the director of the department...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Of Natural Resources.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...to distinguish...okay, then we should say the whole thing every time, the director of the Natural Resources Department, to distinguish that person from somebody who might be the director of a natural resource district? And remember, since these statutes were put in place piecemeal, maybe the only thing that was used was the term "director" once they said director of a resource district. And we may not be amending all of the...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You said time?
