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SENATOR CUDABACK: Did, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Vrtiska, on FA1519.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I rise to support Senator Chambers' amendment. I'd like to ask him a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Chambers, you've got, obviously, a lot of problems that you see with this bill, and you're going to try to correct them. I assume that's what you're about.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Language problems...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Right. Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...right now, and I'm just discussing some of the other weightier areas to see if there should be an attempt to write an amendment.

SENATOR VRTISKA: I understand that. I guess the question I have, and very directly, if you get all these things corrected, are you going to support the bill, or are you...?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: You are.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, it's interesting...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...but let me say this.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...to know, because...
