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there can be refined how ever anybody wants to do it. Maybe I'd put it up there and Senator Cunningham would have an amendment to it. His would be adopted. That wouldn't be satisfactory to everybody, so somebody else would offer an amendment. And that's the way, in my mind, I intend to proceed, so that it's easier for me to keep a handle on what it is we're doing. Senator Schrock has expressed agreement with the amendment that I have up there at this point. It goes along the lines of what I've been doing already. I have called Senator Schrock's attention, and the attention of anybody else who wants to pay attention, to one of these places where there are findings, and that would be on page 63, but there will be another matter that I will touch on briefly, or maybe not so briefly, the next time I am recognized in my own right. Had I taken the time to put a tab of paper on every page where I have an issue, my copy of the committee amendment would look something like a paper porcupine. There is so much in this bill that needs to be discussed, and not necessarily critically, in the sense of being opposed to it, but rather to get an understanding, that if each 1 of us were to take an amount of this bill, a number of pages, that would result from our dividing the total number of bills...of pages by 49, I think we could more easily...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...handle this bill. Each person would go through his or her assigned amount and bring to our attention anything that is worthy of discussion, whether there is agreement with it or not. But when each one of us is going to have to go through this and find those items that we have questions about or that we disagree with, then it becomes difficult, as I am finding great difficulty doing. But I will stumble along and do the best that I can. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock and Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler, on the Chambers amendment, FA1520, to FA1502.
