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SENATOR BEUTLER: ...alternative supplies, incentive payments, compensation, and water transfer mechanisms. Compensation, I assume, means paying people for their water rights. Senator Schrock, I only have one minute left, but I want to go back to that plan and ask you some questions about what the policy group suggested and what we're actually doing, and whether you plan to do some of these things in addition to what's in this bill with respect to funding. I want to flush out a little further the funding on this, and I will take that up on my next opportunity to speak. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. On with discussion of FA1520. Senator Chambers, followed by Senator Janssen and Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I will pass this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers passes. Senator Janssen, you are next.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes, Senator Cudaback, I give my time to Senator Beutler.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen, I'm sorry, I didn't understand you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Give my time to Senator Beutler, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Janssen, thank you very much. Senator Schrock, if we could engage in a little discussion, it would...it would help me understand what the policy task force had in mind, first of all, with regard to the suggestion that there be an additional state sales tax. And the idea was to put this into a trust fund. Is that right?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, do you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That is...that is correct.
