how are those farmers who can't pass on their costs, why are we charging them more through the General Fund rather than having the irrigators who benefit from the irrigation pay at least part of it? Senator Vrtiska's farmers arguably shouldn't be paying for this. They're paying for their competition to outcompete them, in a way. In any event, the kind of fee that you...that you could do would be like a \$50...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...registration fee. How many of you know, and I didn't realize, how much water one center-pivot pumps over 130 acres of land in one year with a foot and a half of water on each acre? That's about what it takes to raise corn in most areas where they're using it. Sixty-three hundred gallons? Sixty three thousand gallons? Six hundred and thirty thousand gallons? Six million three hundred thousand gallons? Sixty-three million gallons? Sixty-three million gallons of water--one center-pivot, one corn crop, one year. Fifty bucks for all of that?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Seems like a bargain to me.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock. This will be your third time, Senator.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Beutler, that will fill your bathtub pretty fast, won't it? Most of the wells that I'm familiar with pump somewhere between 800 and 1,000 gallon a minute, just in 1 minute, and you run those 24 hours a day in the summertime, 7 days a week when it's hot and dry. It's a lot of water. We are blessed. We're truly blessed in this state. Senator Bourne referred to the fact that we could raise \$10 million more money from the NRD levy. I passed out a map yesterday. Only the NRDs that are actively involved in integrated water management plans right now would assess that 1 cent, and I would tell you that the Nemaha NRD probably are not going to put any levy out for integrated water management plans. I doubt whether the Papio NRD is going to do that either. Those are probably the two that
