it's okay. But just looking at it from the point of view of what you and I usually tolerate by way of government bureaucracies, this is incredible. Flip through it. Read through all the bureaucratic provisions. If they want this very expensive bureaucratic process to be sure that the last little inch of fairness is squeezed out of the system, then especially they ought to be able to compromise a little bit on the bill. Maybe there is room for compromise, Senator Schrock, given what...some of the remarks you just made. You want the urban people to contribute to that fee. I'm agreeable to that. I suggest we take the city of Lincoln and determine what their water use is and divide it by the amount of water used by a center-pivot, take that number and multiply it times the \$50 fee that we're charging the irrigation well, and let the city of Lincoln pay \$10,000 or \$15,000 or whatever it comes to, and let the city of Omaha pay \$40,000 or \$50,000 or \$60,000, whatever it comes to. Would you be amenable to a compromise of that type? Well, let me ask, Senator Schimek, if Senator Schrock would...could reply.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Schrock, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I will. Senator Beutler, the answer this time is no.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So your posture on this bill, Senator, is that there is no substantive provision of the bill that can be amended? Is that your position?

SENATOR SCHROCK: No, it is not. But I think it's important that the state put some money into it. And we're not getting all the money we want, or probably need, but we're getting a start.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And Senator, I have no objection to the state putting some money into it. But it seems to me that it should be...there should be some area or place for compromise in there. I get the feeling that I'm the one that's not compromising. And I can think of lots of things that I would change in the bill. And there's not a single thing I've asked to change...I have one
