SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would ask for a call of the house, and I will accept call-in votes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: There has been a request for a call of the house. Would all senators please...wait a minute. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Beutler, would you check in, please? Senator Brashear, Senator Vrtiska, Senator Friend, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Brown, Quandahl, Senator Kruse, Senator Preister. Mr. Clerk, I understand that call-in votes have been authorized.
