SENATOR CUDABACK: No objection? So ordered.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, with the striking of some of this language, the amendment is even more easily understood. On page 8, in line 16, I would strike "personally" and insert "by personal service." In line 19, I would strike the two words "arrive at" and insert "reach." The reason I am doing this is to properly identify a method of serving notice. Although in ordinary conversations, it might be said that a person was personally served, meaning that the notice was given directly to that individual, but the terminology when you're describing the type of service it is, the proper terminology would be personal service. So the language would say with my amendment: if the notice is being served by personal service or by registered or certified mail. So I am asking you to strike the word "personally" and insert "by personal service." In line 19, rather than saying using information used by the department to arrive at the preliminary determinations, I'm striking "arrive at" and I am putting the word "reach," which means the information used by the department to reach the preliminary determinations. At other locations in the bill where new language is proposed and maybe where existing language already is present, the word "reach" is used when talking about this preliminary determination. What I am striking from the amendment is the part that would have dealt with the word "determinations." I would have stricken the plural, inserted the singular, but having been prevailed upon by counsel of Senator Schrock that the plural form of the word is what is needed, I have acceded to that and agree with it. So the amendment I'm offering is now in the form that I have just discussed. The word "personally" will be stricken and replaced "by personal service." The words "arrive at" will be stricken to be replaced by the word "reach." If you have any questions, I will answer them.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The substituted amendment has the same number as the original amendment as it was not read into the record yet. So we are discussing yet FA1528 offered by Senator Chambers to the first division. Open
