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wrong with going to the people and them deciding if it should be in there. I don't think Jim Cudaback should decide what should be in the constitution. It's just that simple with me. Maybe I'm a simple person. But it's that simple. Let the people decide. Put it before them. It's just the way I am. Kids, 4-H; it seems like nowadays we would rather treat than prevent. You know, I don't like prisons. I don't like prisons. I think we could do a lot if we would try to prevent our young people from going to prison than sending them and then throwing away the key. Lock them up, just lock them up. Put them in...down below in the caverns, or wherever they put them. I don't like that. I think we can prevent them from going there, give them some type of program, get them...you know, we can do this. And I think this is what something like a State Fair does. It helps to prevent kids from doing these things. If you say no, no, no, no, no all the time to a kid, don't let them do anything, they're going to wind up doing just the opposite. But if you can kind of show them the right direction, give them some things to go to, give them some things to do, give them a penny, give them 2 cents for an award, you know. I mean, a dime may make us laugh, but to a dime...kid, you know, it means something. Give them a pink ribbon. Big deal. Give them a pink ribbon. Give them a blue ribbon. Big deal. But it means something to that person. It meant something to me. Maybe that's why I'm such a good person; I got some ribbons. You know, who knows why we turn out the way we do. Who knows. You know, we don't know. Somebody is laughing because I said I was a good person. Well, maybe I'm not such a good person. I don't know. But anyway, you know, I just think that we're here to do one thing. And we don't want to cut our nose off to make our face mad, or however that phrase goes. You know, we don't need to do that. We should let the people decide this here. To me, it's just that simple. Let the people decide. Put it to them. If they don't want it, fine. I don't care. Let the State Fair die. We'll be the only one in 50, but that's...we have 50 states, I guess. Be 49 that have state fairs; Nebraska don't. I'll travel to Texas. Texas has got a great one. I've been to Texas State Fair, I've been to New York State Fair, I've been to Iowa State Fair. I've been to a lot of state fairs. And I guess I don't have to go to Nebraska State Fair. But it would be kind of nice to go to your own. Some people can't afford to travel to another state fair.
