program. And I also think we ought to look at Husker Harvest Days. We ought to talk to Grand Island. We ought to see where things are succeeding. And I know that that's not being recommended by the State Fair people. But we do have other options in the state. We have local fairs. We have city festivals. There are lots of things that people can go to and enjoy. But again, my primary concern is that this does not rise to the level of education and the environment. And that's a statement we are recommending to the people, that this rises to that level for those funds. Thank you.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator. We have a priority motion, Mr. Clerk?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to bracket the resolution until April 15.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Should I begin?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Chambers, to open on your motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, I'm not going to take this motion to a vote, but I want to complete what I was saying. I may have said just enough to tantalize or to confuse people. But if you look at the committee amendment, you will see that every bit of money that is being accounted for in terms of where it goes is going into a fund, except for the State Fair. There is no State Fair fund it will go into that the Legislature can drain as it can these other funds. It goes to the State Fair Board. So the State Fair Board is guaranteed its money, and you can't take it back once they've got it. But every one of these funds can be abolished. Every one of them can be drained. I shouldn't even say anything else on this, and just let you behave like a bunch of hicks who think that the constitution is less worthy than the State Fair. This is not the first time I've been outraged at somebody's attempt to contaminate, trivialize, and abase the constitution. I've only got four more years to be here, but in those four years this constitution, that I had only one part to play in, and that was indirectly--and that was having them put term limits in, and that's the worst thing they could have done,
