CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Mr. Resident.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Unexcused members, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Chambers has requested a roll call vote in reverse order. Senator Jensen, Senator Engel, Senator Jones. Senator Schimek, would you check in please? Senator Burling, Senator Kruse, Senator Quandahl. Senator Smith, if you would check in please? Senator Beutler, please check in. Senator Engel, would you check in please? Senator Jensen, Senator Jones, Senator Kruse. Senator Thompson, we're unable to locate three members yet at this point, Senators Jensen, Jones, and Kruse.
