There's livestock show down at Broken Bow through the winter that's getting to be recognized statewide. So you've lost the livestock shows that used to be always in Nebraska. They've went to...now they're promoting entertainment. And as some of the discussion has been going on for the last day or so on this, that they're talking about what they can do to make the area better so that they can have people come for their entertainment and that sort of thing. So really you're getting down to, you're selling some type of facility to have your stage shows or whatever you have for your entertainment and your buildings to have it in. You...the people in Omaha now have a huge convention center coming in. So whatever you do in that line, you'll be competing with that. You have your Devaney Sports Center next-door there, and some of the things that I've read about it is, some of these rock concert type deals, that they really don't feel they have enough seating in the Devaney Sports Center to be able to sell the tickets and make money on that. So there's a lot of things that have transpired over the years. And at the present time, why, I think changes have been made, and they're probably going to have to think of new ideas, think of new ways to manage this thing, think of new ways what we're going to do with our State Fair, and think of...consider the ways that you want it to go. Is it going to be a...something for the entertainment industry? If it is, then you would probably have to change it for the time of the year. At the present time, your State Fair competes with, many times, football games every other year. They compete with the River City Roundup in Omaha. And...

SENATOR ENGEL: One minute.

SENATOR LOUDEN: ...not only that, you have your Lancaster County Fair going on at the same time. So I think that was the reason I'm...have looked farther west to the...like Mitchell, Nebraska.
