SENATOR BAKER: That is correct.

SENATOR ERDMAN: As we look at the language on page 9, line 16, subsection (8), where it talks about applicat...for applicants for projects that are not receiving benefits filed before the effective date of this act, and then it also says, for applicants filed on or after the effective date of this act, taxpayer. That's the new language on page 9. The previous language would have allowed an applicant prior to access any credits that was available in the current language that's on lines 19 through 23, correct?

SENATOR BAKER: Correct.

SENATOR ERDMAN: So realistically, what you're doing is you're changing the opportunity for an individual to access those credits after the fact?

SENATOR BAKER: Run that past again? We're changing the what? This...that language is saying they're still eligible for LB 775 if they're not receiving EPIC funds. For applic...go ahead, it's your time.

SENATOR ERDMAN: No, go ahead.

SENATOR BAKER: Well, what we're trying to do is to prevent double-dipping into LB 775 and LB 536. However, we want to make sure here that if they do not qualify for EPIC fund incentives, which if this is tight enough that they can't come in under the 100,000-gallon portable still, then we don't want to discourage them to the point that they can't also...they can't access LB 775. They may not be eligible for LB 536, but they are eligible for LB 775. One or the other, but not both.

SENATOR ERDMAN: And so that's the new language on the bottom of page 9, is ensuring that they have that opportunity?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR ERDMAN: The discussion that you had with Senator Chambers about the length of period that you have to submit
