"State Fair Board." That is the area where you're talking about money being transferred to the State Fair Board. I would strike that language and, instead, the money would be transferred to "Health and Human Services System for establishment and implementation of a treatment program for HIV/AIDS." On page 3, in line 14, I would strike "Nebraska State Fair," and insert "treatment of HIV/AIDS." Before I go into that, I want to just poke fun at Senator Preister and those he is working with. He presented an amendment which Senator Landis persuaded him to remove at this time and offer on Select File. If this bill goes to Select File, I assure you it's not going beyond that, but it will give us something to talk about over there, too, should there be enough suckers to vote for this. And that's what you'll be, because you'll be rooked in, just like the public, except you are worse because you are the ones dangling something in front of the suckers.
