Why do you all even get angry with me? You know the way I'm going to do. You bait me. You provoke me. You slap me. You annoy and antagonize me; then you don't want me to respond. SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

He doesn't run me. But he runs this Legislature. So you all are afraid of him? I'll punish him for you. I will take care of the bully. You all are the 97-pound weakling and he's kicked sand in your face. Then I will take care of that bully. I know how to deal with him, and I fear nothing from him or anything he and those like him and who support him can do. We're playing hardball.
