SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question before the body is the adoption of FA1541. All in favor of that amendment please vote aye, and opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Chambers has requested a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please...unexcused, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Chambers, you asked for a roll call vote?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Stuhr, Senator McDonald, Senator Bourne. Members, the question before us is the adoption of the Chambers amendment, FA1541. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 914-915.) 10 ayes, 15 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I call the question on the advancement of LR 209CA.

SPEAKER BROMM: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question then is, shall we cease debate? All in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.
