SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler indicates he will accept call-in votes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction) Roll call vote.

SPEAKER BROMM: And a roll call vote has been requested. And we'll wait for Senators Quandahl and Preister. Senator Preister. All are present that are not excused. Mr. Clerk, proceed to call the roll. Members, I'll remind us all, we're voting on calling the question.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 926.) 32 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SPEAKER BROMM: Debate does cease. And I will raise the call. We will go to closing on the motion to substitute. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. I simply urge you to vote for the motion to substitute AM2917 for the three divisions that are already on the board. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the closing. The question before us is the motion to substitute Senator Schimek's amendment. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to substitute.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is successful. The amendment is substituted. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to open on the amendment. Senator Smith. (AM2917, Legislative Journal pages 926-927.)

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I would ask that AM2670 be withdrawn, pursuant to Rule 7, Section 3, stating that a motion, my motion, can be withdrawn prior to the vote being taken. Thank you.
