SENATOR STUHR: He will be after...after this bill gets passed.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How will he be violating the law?

SENATOR STUHR: Well, he will...he will not be able to, I guess, to perform those services.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if he does, they will try to get an injunction against him.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But if he's moving, how will they find him to serve him with the legal papers?

SENATOR STUHR: Well, I think that that is what's happening in fact, because we don't have any law on our books today or any statutes regulating this industry.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Let me interrupt you, before my time runs out, for you to think about something.

SENATOR STUHR: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If a young person is going to have this done, would you...against the parents' wishes, would you rather it be done by somebody trained and with the proper equipment and facility, or by some other young person in the alley, in a garage or just a room? You don't have to answer now because there's not enough time. And, Mr. President, I know...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...my time is up. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is time. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bourne, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you. Thank you, Mr. President, members. Would Senator Stuhr yield to another question or two?
