for which the applicant is seeking licensure, including, but not limited to, a practical examination. I wish Senator Bourne might catch this because it's in line with what he was talking about. When you put the language, Senator Bourne, on line 14, in subsection (e), the words are "but not limited to, a practical examination to test the applicant's knowledge of safety, sanitation, and sterilization techniques" and so forth, but if the test is not limited to those things, then obviously more than that can be required in the examination. And in order to pass such an examination, you can be required to take certain courses or other things. It doesn't say that the department notifies the public of what the examination will consist of so you're going to know what's required of you. All of that is done by way of examination, rules and regulation. When you start out on page 13, where Senator Bourne called our attention, in subdivision (a), this person who is the applicant has complied already with the Nebraska Cosmetology Act and the applicable rules and regulations adopted and promulgated under the act. The person has complied with all of that. But in addition to having complied with that act, all these other things.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So apparently all these other things are not included in complying with the act. But if you've already complied with the act, why pile on other things to do? What it looks like is that there was just a collection of items on the table and they were just picked up willy-nilly and put into this bill, and some of them are inconsistent and, in my mind, conflicting and even contradictory, but this is very, very broad language. I hadn't even gotten to this part of the bill yet, but I'm glad Senator Bourne called our attention to it, and it shows the reason why this bill should not be moved today. Thank you, Mr. President.
