SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. You've heard the closing on AM2973, which is an amendment to AM2963, which is an amendment to LB 906. All in favor of AM2973 vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Stuhr amendment to an amendment, being AM2963, LB 906. Have you all voted who care to? Senator Stuhr, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR STUHR: I'd like a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All authorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Janssen, will you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Mossey, Senator Jones, Senator Schimek, would you check in, please? Thank you. Senator Quandahl, Senator Burling, Senator Stuthman, Senator Preister, and Senator Thompson. The house is under call. Senator Kruse. Senator Mossey, Senators Jones, Quandahl, and Kruse. Senators Stuthman and Preister. Senator...Senator Quandahl and Senator Preister. Senator Quandahl, the house is under call. Please report to the Chamber. Senator Stuhr, did you permit call-in votes? I can't hear you, Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: No, let's go ahead and vote on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You want to have to have a roll call then.
