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Committee, reports on several appointments to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission. (Legislative Journal page 902.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, to open on your report.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members. The Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee also heard, on the same day as the previous three who were heard, the appointments of Marilee Fredrickson, Andre Barry, and Gary Rosacker to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission. And one of those is a gubernatorial appointment, and that is Marilee Fredrickson, and she is a reappointment, and she is from Omaha, is a business owner, owns Signature Performance, and seemed very well-qualified for the position. The second person was Andre Barry, who is an attorney here in Lincoln, and he is an appointee of the Secretary of State, and he's one of those appointees that comes on the...upon the recommendation of the state party. And he...and I said I think he's an attorney here in Lincoln. And then the third one was Gary Rosacker, who's also a Secretary of State appointee, and he's from G.I. He is an agent, an insurance agency principal, and both of those last two were new appointments. With that, Mr. President, I would simply urge the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. You've heard the opening on the second report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, Chairperson Schimek. Senator Schimek, did you mean to have your light on? Okay. Thank you. Any further discussion on the report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee? Senator Schimek, there are no lights on. She waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of the report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. All in favor of the report vote aye, opposed nay. Question before the body is the second report offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
