and show competency in if he or she is going to become licensed to perform these activities. Then other language to consider adding: No person without a license may perform body art on another person and receive compensation for services performed. Failure to adhere to this would be a Class III misdemeanor. Now, by adding the requirement of compensation, it takes a lot of people out from under the bill as far as being subject to a criminal sanction. I would have to review that and look at the place in the bill where it will be added to be sure that existing language, when incorporating with Senator Stuhr's offering, will not throw the net broader than it ought to be spread. But I think this is a very acceptable, from my point of view, good faith effort to address a problematic area of the bill. So here's what I have to ask Senator Stuhr, if she will respond to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Stuhr, would you respond?

SENATOR STUHR: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Stuhr, in looking at the practicality of handling this bill, how are we going to be able to get this done?

SENATOR STUHR: I think the...if we are dealing with only Sections or lines 8 through 20, I believe that we could do it with an amendment. I have some other things that I could share with the body, if that would be possible.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would support an amendment of this kind, but here's what I would also say. If we adopt it, then I would still want to review it to be sure that we have in it what we need. I don't think, with what I see here, that it's going to be overbroad, as some of the existing language is, but we never know for sure. So after we get through working the bill this morning, there would still be the opportunity, even if the bill is advanced to Final Reading, to bring it back to do any other cleaning up that needs to be done, and I think it's not too difficult to identify those of us who have an interest and we could come together and see what we might arrive at.
