transaction of the Department of Banking, and this was a bill that passed from committee without any dissent. So I would urge the adoption of AM2778.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. You've heard the opening on AM2778 which is an amendment to LB 999. We're now open for discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Quandahl. Open for discussion. Senator Quandahl, there are no lights on. You're recognized to close if you care to. Did you waive closing? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is the adoption of the AM2778 offered by Senator Quandahl to LB 999. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is the Quandahl amendment, AM2778. Have you all voted who wish to on AM2778? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Quandahl's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Quandahl amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment, Senator Quandahl, AM2933, but I have a note you want to withdraw that, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Is that true?

SENATOR QUANDAHL: That is correct. I would ask that that be withdrawn.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It also is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, AM2899, but again, Senator, a note you wish to withdraw AM2899.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend with AM2959. (Legislative Journal page 928.)
