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FLOOR DEBATE

March 9, 2004 LB 888

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Mr. Clerk, next motion.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend with FA1538. (Legislative Journal page 946.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on FA1538 to LB 888.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. As I was reading this chunk of language in lines 4 through we may as well say 18, there are numerous items and units containing other items in this chunk of language. And things are set off by commas, but it's difficult to tell what goes with what. So what I'm doing is inserting some lowercase letters to designate how the itemization should read. So on page 5 in line 7 before the word "to" t-o, I would insert the letter (a); line 9 before the word "to" I would insert the letter (b); line 10 before "to" the letter (c); line 11 before the word "to" (d); line 12 before the word "to" the letter (e); line 13 before the word "to" the letter (f); line 15 before the word "to" the letter (g); and farther along on line 15 before the second "to" the letter (h); in line 16 before the word "to" the letter (i). That is what this amendment would do. And I doubt that anybody wants to speak on it, but if they do, I will answer whatever questions they may have.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the opening on FA1538. Open for discussion on that motion. There are no lights on, Senator Chambers. Did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of FA1538 offered by Senator Chambers to LB 888. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Chambers amendment FA1538 to LB 888. Have you all voted on the motion who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator
