very quickly. But I didn't see it, so the draft did not match the understanding.

SENATOR MINES: All right. Mr. President, I've not seen the language yet and, in deference to our process and in deference to Senator Landis, I will withdraw AM2981.

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered. The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Quandahl would move to amend with AM2282. (Legislative Journal page 974.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Quandahl, to open on AM2282 to LB 999.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I did just file a quick amendment on LB 999 that deals with something that we talked about when the bill was first introduced so many days ago. It deals with a small statutory change to Section 8-113, and this was a part of the original bill, LB 999, to add an additional exemption to that provision. As you may recall on the original discussion of LB 999, we've already excepted 501(c)(3) corporations, such as blood banks, food banks, and this would simply make LB 999 consistent with UCC Section 405 (sic), Section 1. And so I would urge the adoption of AM2282. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. You've heard the opening on AM2282. Open for discussion. Senator Quandahl, did you wish to address it also? Your light was on first. He passes on that. Senator Beutler, you may...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Pass.

SENATOR CUDABACK: He waives also. Any further senators wishing to speak to the Quandahl amendment? Seeing none, Senator Quandahl...I'm sorry, Senator Hartnett. Did you wish to?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes. Mr. President, members, we have a large credit union in my district, Senator.
