SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Jensen requests a call of the house and will take call-in votes. All those in favor of the house going under call please vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The house is under call. Senators, please take your seats and record your presence. Thank you. Senator Brashear, Senator Raikes, Senator Kruse, Senator Schrock, Senator Baker, Senator Wehrbein, Senator Vrtiska, Senator Cudaback, Senator Mines, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Senator Jensen has authorized call-in votes. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Brashear voting yes. Senator Dwite Pedersen voting yes. Senator Aguilar voting yes. Senator Maxwell voting yes. Senator Wehrbein voting yes. Senator Vrtiska voting yes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The amendment is adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Foley would move to amend with AM2928. (Legislative Journal page 968.)

SENATOR JANSSEN: The Chair recognizes Senator Foley, to open on his amendment.

AM2928 before you is the revised form of a bill I offered earlier this year, LB 1155, which advanced out of committee on a unanimous vote.
