and a white organization said that...not an organization, a white entity--the Kerner Commission. There are two societies in this country, one black and one white, and never the twain meet except to clash. And it's because the white one is determined to make the black one subservient, and whatever the white people say is right, is right, not because it is right, but because they say it's right. And they're going to force our children into a mold that they don't fit in. They say, well, our children carry on in such and such a way and this is the way they react. That's not our children, and they don't care about our children. And competent black people have difficulty getting jobs in the schools because they're perceived as a threat. They would call attention to these deficiencies and from the inside be in a position to get information to people like me on the outside and we would cooperate to improve the plight of our children. And you all don't like to hear this. I don't care. You are too comfortable in the presence of the misery of my children, but I'm not going to sit here and let you all do this. If that amendment comes downstairs and it leaves that starting date at October 15, you're quit of me on this bill. And I would give a little piece of advice. Don't agree with...to something with me and then let me find out, out of a clear blue sky, that that's not the way it is. That's not the way I deal with you all. I tell you what my position is. If I work with you on something and we've come to an understanding and my mind changes on it, I tell you. I tell you as soon as that happens and as soon as I can get to you and let you know that I'm seeing this a different way. So you all just need to understand that there is a quick way to get on the, figuratively speaking, fighting side of me. Just let me see that missionary in you. You can't even deal with your own children. When I open the newspaper and I see where children have killed their parents, it's not black children. It's happening in suburban areas where black people are not even allowed to live. It's white children. While you're building walls around your communities and putting gates across the streets, you're not walling me and my kind out. You're walling the monster in with you. The monster is not under the bed. The monster is in that little child's bed in your house. So what is wrong with white society? White people are now taking a different attitude toward heroin because it is relatively cheaper, the level of
