ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 599A by Senator Tyson.
(Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, would you like to open on
LB 599A?

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President. LB 599 has an A bill
attached. I would like to bring it to your attention that this
is a cash-funded board, and while there are...while they do
spend money, that money is generated by fees and, therefore,
there is no General Fund money in it. I would read the last
part of the fiscal note: The Legislative Fiscal Office notes
that the estimated expenditures and revenues balance over a
two-year period. However, if the annual revenue amount will
only be about \$150,000 per year, the agency will have to adjust
their revenues and/or expenditures to the future. In effect,
the industry carries the board and there is no net effect on the
General Fund itself. And I ask that you advance LB 599A to
E & R for initial. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Tyson. You've heard the
opening on LB 599A. Open for discussion? Seeing no lights on,
Senator Tyson, did you wish to close? He waives closing. The
